

# FLOWER DESCRIPTION CHART

<b><i>Amaryllis</i></b>	Usually deep red, also available in white. Shaped similar to a lily with a long stem.
<b><i>Anemones</i></b>	Available in white, blue, red violet, yellow. Shaped similar to poppies.
<b><i>Asters</i></b>	Usually available in white, pink, rose, and purple.
<b><i>Baby's Breath</i></b>	Usually white. Fine delicate, tiny flowers.
<b><i>Bachelor Buttons</i></b>	Available in white, pink, red, blue. They look like tiny carnations.
<b><i>Calla Lily</i></b>	White with yellow center. Unusual shape with long stems.
<b><i>Canterbury Bells</i></b>	Usually blue, purple, or pink. Shaped like little bells.
<b><i>Carnations</i></b>	Available in many colors. Very fragrant. A commonly known flower.
<b><i>Catlaya Orchids</i></b>	Usually white with shades of pink or lavender in the center of each petal. Larger than other orchids.
<b><i>Chrysanthemum</i></b>	Available in white, yellow, red. They come in many shapes and sizes.
<b><i>Daffodils</i></b>	Available in many colors. A pretty flower that is very common.
<b><i>Daisies</i></b>	Usually white or yellow with yellow center. A popular flower similar, but smaller than a chrysanthemum.
<b><i>Day Lily</i></b>	Usually in shades of cream, orange, red, yellow with a variety of stem lengths.
<b><i>Delphinium</i></b>	Usually in white, rose, lavender, blue. Long spikes of flowers with lacy foliage.
<b><i>Forget-me-not</i></b>	Dainty blue flower with yellow or white centers. Very pretty.
<b><i>Gardenias</i></b>	Pretty white flower with dark green leaves. Very fragrant.
<b><i>Iris</i></b>	Available in white, blue, violet, yellow, and orange. Long stalks, large petals with two that drop down a little.
<b><i>Lilac</i></b>	Usually white or lavender. Stalks with many tiny flowers. Very fragrant.
<b><i>Lily</i></b>	Usually white or cream with tinges of pink or lavender.
<b><i>Lily of the Valley</i></b>	White flowers. Bell-shaped and clustered on a long spike stem. Very fragrant and delicate.
<b><i>Orchid</i></b>	Usually white, or in shades of pink or lavender. Popular and common flower.
<b><i>Roses</i></b>	Available in a number of colors. A bud at the end of a long, thorned stem. Buds vary in size down to a miniature rose with a bud of less than one inch. Very popular and fragrant.
<b><i>Spray Orchid</i></b>	Long spikes covered with tiny orchid-like flowers.
<b><i>Stephanotis</i></b>	These are white trumpet-shaped flowers which grow on vines. Popular in bouquets and have a sweet fragrance.
<b><i>Strawflowers</i></b>	Available in white, yellow, orange, red. Straw-like petals shaped like daisies.
<b><i>Violets</i></b>	Available in white, blue, purple. Tiny flowers with a nice fragrance.
<b><i>Zephyr Lily</i></b>	Available in white, yellow, and shades of pink. Smaller than most lilies.
